



Hello Families and welcome to Possums.

In the Possums room there are two main educators, with a third Educator in a support role.

Our goals for the room are:

- Settling into the Possums Room and becoming familiar with the environment, limits, routines and educators.
- Practicing and developing our self-help skills and independence
- Providing a safe, warm, welcoming space for the children to grow and enjoy throughout the year.

Our daily routine is found below our curriculum on the wall. We encourage our new families to read through it to familiarise themselves with your child's new room. During morning tea, unlike Joeys, the children consume milk with their food in cups. If your child does require a milk bottle we offer their milk bottles just before sleep time. We ask that each child bring a water bottle (Water only), Sun hat, Sunscreen (If a specific one is required), plenty of spare clothes (We sometimes make a mess while learning through play!), one comforter for rest time (if required). We ask that all clothes, hats and water/milk bottles be **labelled** clearly with your child's name. In the Possums room the children's bags are hanging outside on hooks. We ask that you remove, water bottles and milk bottles and place in the water caddy and milk bottle basket respectively in order for us to be ready for the day. Hats stay in the children's bags and are taken out for the day then put back in at the end of the day.
